The Canadian Dental Care Plan (CDCP)

The Canadian Dental Care Plan (CDCP) is a federal government program intended to provide dental coverage for Canadian residents who **do not have dental benefits** and have a household income of **less than \$90,000 a year**.

The CDCP is a federal government dental benefit administered by Health Canada. **It is not a free dental program**.

Patients may be required to make a co-payment of **up to 60%** depending on their adjusted family net income. They may also have to pay additional costs the CDCP does not cover.

Before proceeding with treatment, it is important to understand your dental care costs.

Not all dental services are covered under the CDCP.

Please tell your dental provider if you plan to use CDCP benefits. The office may or may not participate in the federal program.
